

COLOURING WITH DAUBERS AND SPONGES

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COLOURING A BACKGROUND STAMP WITH DAUBERS OR SPONGES

I have used the Breathtaking Bouquet Stamp set to show off this technique but any background or large stamp can be used. The image is white embossed but here again you can stamp with black ink prior to colouring if you do not have this option.

The colours are a guideline and any combination could be used.



Supplies:

- Card stock: Thick Whisper White 21cm x 14.5cm
Gray Granite 13.5 x 10cm
Whisper White 13 x 9.5 cm and a scrap for Sentiment.(or Black)
- Stamp Set: Breathtaking Bouquet
- Ink: Highland Heather, Pool Party, Gray Granite, Pear Pizzaz and
Versamark, if not embossing Black Memento

Embellishments: From My Heart Faceted Gems

Other: White Embossing Powder, Embossing Buddy, Heat Tool,
Sponge Daubers, Stamparatus or large Stamp Block,
Multipurpose Liquid Glue and Dimensionals.



Instructions:

1. Fold the Thick Whisper White Card Stock in half (at 10.5 cm) and Glue the Gray Granite Mat to the front.
2. Either Stamp with Black Ink or White emboss the Whisper White card stock with the image.
3. Taking a dauber start with the Highland Heather (purple Ink) firstly dab on a scrap piece of paper to prevent blotches then work in even Circular motions.
4. Always start lightly and build the colour to the desired
5. Repeat using different Daubers for each colour building up the colours.
6. When you are happy with the colours adhere this to the Gray Granite mat
7. Using either the White card stock and Black ink or the Black card stock and White Embossing add your Sentiment. I have used Happy Birthday and just manually cut out the words.
8. Using Dimensionals place the sentiment on the card
9. Place on embellishments. X 3-5 in a triangle type pattern
10. Stamp on the inside of card with stamp of choice and the envelope if desired.
