Supplies

Stamps: Birds & Branches, Forever Fern

Ink: Bumble Bee, daffodil Delight, Gray Granite, Magenta Madness, Crumb cake, Old Olive, Pool Party, Balmy Blue, Versamark

Card/Paper: Whisper White thick, Whisper White, pool Party, Gold Foil, Basic Black, Fluid water Colour. Paper

Accessories: Gilded Gems, Pool Party Sheer Ribbon, Basic Pearls

Tools: Birds and More Dies, Tasteful Textures Embossing Folder

Other: White Embossing Powder, Heat Tool, Dimensionals, All Purpose Glue and Tape. Soft Suede Stampin Blend



Instructions

Base and Front Cut Thick Whisper White Card base at 14.8cm x 29cm Score at 10.5cm.

Cut pool Party card (first Mat) 10cm x 14.3cm.

Cut Whisper White (second mat) 9.5cm x 13.8cm. Stamp nest in Gray Granite on the center of this card base. Stamp Branches in Crumcake and corresponding leaves in Old Olive around the nest in Approximately 3 places or as desired. Once Stamping complete emboss with Tasteful Textures Embossing Folder.

On a piece of Whisper White stamp 3 flowers in Magenta Madness, two birds in Bumble Bee and Daffodil Delight, a nest in Gray Granite and Die cut all of these.

Using the leaf die, cut one branch in the Gold foil.

Mix some Pool Party and Balmy Blue together making sure It is not too dark (this will be similar to duck egg blue). When dry flick with the. Soft Suede Blend creating small dots. Using Egg Die cut out the 3 Eggs.

Adhere white stamped mat onto pool Party Mat. Wrap Ribbon around the front adhere and tie bow. Place these two Mats with ribbon on dimensionals and adhere on top of card base.

Place dimensionals under nest and adhere on top of the stamped image. Split the Gold foil leaves into 3 and adhere under nest. Adhere the two birds with dimensionals and glue the flowers and eggs.

White emboss the words on black card and cut around the words and adhere to the top of nest.

Place a pearl in the Centre of each flower and 3 Gilded Gems on card front.

Card Inner: Stamp on the inside a bird with Bumble, and Daffodil Ink.
