

Making the Most of Your Designer Series Paper

Using Every Piece of Your 6 x6 DSP

Stamps: Pretty Perennial

Ink: Night of Navy, Seaside Foam

Card/Paper: Thick Basic White, Basic White, paper blooms designer Series Paper

Accessories: Linen Thread, Opal Rounds

Tools: Decorative mask, Blending Brush

Other: All Purpose Glue, Dimensionals, Glue Dots



Instructions

Base Cut Thick Basic White cardstock measuring 9.6cm x 10.5 cm or 11 5/8 x 4 1/8 "

Score @ 14.8cm or 5 7/8 "

Cut a Piece of DSP at 2cm x 14.8cm or 6/8 x 11 5/8 "

Mask a section with either post it notes or tape approx. 3.5cm wide or 1 1/2 " Place the Decorative mask on top and hold firmly. Using the Blending Brush Cover the area evenly with ink. Go back over and blend more at the bottom getting lighter as you reach the top.. remove tape and adhere your DSP strip down the left hand side of the card front.

Stamp Happy in Night of Navy at the top of Card.

Stamp Birthday on Basic White and Cut out, adhere to bottom right of card front

Cut out and arrange flowers on the Front as desired.

Place Opal Round embellishments in center of flowers and some on the card as desired.

Finish with a Linen Thread Bow at the base of the flower arrangement.

Inside of Card

Stamp a matching flower on the inside of card and envelope.
